

SAFETY RULES

Dunnellon Farm Days Antique Tractor and Equipment Show

These rules have been established to assist our exhibitors in the interest of safety for themselves as well as the guests and spectators at our event. Compliance with these common sense rules will help ensure the greater enjoyment and safety of everyone.

- Each exhibitor will provide a double rope and stanchions to separate operating equipment by a minimum of 3 feet from the spectators.
- A working fire extinguisher (appropriate to the hazards present) is required for each operating exhibit.
- Flammables are to be stored in approved containers at least 6 feet from sources of ignition and from the required fire extinguisher.
- All operating equipment must be attended by a knowledgeable person at all times.
- Exhaust from operating engines and equipment should be directed away from exhibitors where possible.
- Operating lawn mowers in your exhibit must have blades removed or discharge chutes blocked.
- Exhibit areas are to be kept free of clutter to prevent injury from trips and falls.
- Equipment must be operated in a safe manner. Engines must not be operated beyond the rated RPM or load.
- Special precautions must be taken with belt operated equipment to protect spectators.
- Exhibit vehicles must be operated at a safe speed. All passengers are to be on designed seating (not riding on fenders or hood).
- Small children are to be supervised at all times and not allowed to endanger themselves at the exhibits.
- Pets must be under physical control by their owners. Clean up after your pets.
- Warning signs must be conspicuously posted where appropriate.
- This is a family friendly event. Please do not consume alcoholic beverages during the show hours.

A safety officer for the event shall have the right and responsibility to restrict any person who is observed to be driving or operating equipment in an unsafe manner.
